

NEW LEGISLATION NEW LORRIES and a NEW LOOK!

From as early as 2019 new government emission laws will create Clean Air Zones across England and Scotland. One of the first zones to be created is Leeds City Centre and by 2020, Gateshead, Newcastle, Middlesbrough, Glasgow, Edinburgh, Dundee and Aberdeen will follow suit.

Henry Colbeck has already started a 5 year plan to make sure that we transport your goods to you within the guidelines of these new Clean Air Zones.

By the end of 2017 we will have taken delivery of 6 new vehicles in Scotland and 7 new vehicles in England.

These new vehicles are state of the art Euro 6 Wagons.

Their aero-dynamic profile will reduce our carbon foot print by decreasing the amount of fuel needed to make deliveries.

The refrigeration systems will be using R452A refrigerant which will have a 45% immediate reduction environmental impact without affecting the performance of the vehicles.

We are aiming to make our delivery service both eco-efficient and safe with the introduction of infra-red reversing cameras, load restraints and new locking systems for maximum security.

The new interior cab designs, driving aids, air-conditioning and reduced noise levels will all help to create a more comfortable, less stressful, safe and secure environment for our drivers.

The new laws we will be operating under are some of the strictest in the world to ensure that we continue to improve our environmental performance.
